
WOOLECO:

Matterhorn Hat & Cowl

Hit the slopes or the shops in this gorgeous hat & cowl set knit in Hedgehog Fibres Tweedy. The timeless diamond colorwork pattern is updated with colorful bits of tweed that are comprised of recycled yarn & thread waste.

Materials

- (Hat) Size US 4 & 5, 16" circular needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)
- □ (Hat) Size US 5 double point needles
- □ (Cowl) Size US 4 & 5, 24" circular needle
- Tapestry needle
- Faux Fur Pom if desired

Yarn

- Hedgehog Fibres Tweedy (50%
 Falkland Merino Wool, 37.5% Recycled
 Wool, 12.5% Thread Waste), 251
 yards/100g
- □ Color A: 1 skein Tweedy Noir
- □ Color B: 1 skein Tweedy Soot
- □ Color C: 1 skein Tweedy Original

Note- 3 skeins is enough to knit both the hat & cowl. Cowl= 117 yards Noir + 67 yarns each Soot & Original. Hat= 180 yards of Noir + 210 yards each Soot & Original.

Gauge (both hat & cowl)

22.5 sts and 26 rows = 4 inch square in colorwork pattern with larger needle (blocked)

Measurements

Hat Circumference: 17" (19", 21.5")

Cowl Circumference: 25"

Cowl Height: 10"

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Hat Pattern Instructions

Cast-on & Brim

With color A & smaller, 16" circular needle, CO 96 (108, 120) stitches

Place marker & join to work in the round

Round 1: *K1, P1; repeat from * to end

Repeat round 1 until ribbing measures 1" (1.5", 1.5")

from CO edge

Change to larger, 16" circular needle

Body

With color A

Set-up round: K

Knit rounds 1-24 of colorwork chart one time

Repeat knit rounds 1-20 of colorwork chart one more time

Crown Shaping

Note-change to double point needles when stitches do not comfortably fit on circular needle

With color C

Rounds 1-3: K

Round 4: *K4, k2tog; repeat from * to end

80 (90, 100) stitches remain

Rounds 5-6: K

Round 7: *K3, k2tog; repeat from * to end

64 (72, 80) stitches remain

Rounds 8-9: K

Round 10: *K2, k2tog; repeat from * to end

48 (54, 60) stitches remain

Rounds 11-12: K

Round 13: *K1, k2tog; repeat from * to end

32 (36, 40) stitches remain

Rounds 14-15: K

Round 16: *k2tog; repeat from * to end

16 (18, 20) stitches remain

Round 17: K

Round 18: *k2tog; repeat from * to end

8 (9, 10) stitches remain

Finishing

Cut yarn leaving a 6"-8" tail

Using tapestry needle, weave yarn through remaining stitches to secure & bind-off

Weave in ends

Lightly wet or steam block

Top with faux fur pom if desired

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Cowl Pattern Instructions

Cast-on & Ribbing

With color A & smaller, 24" needle, CO 144 stitches

Place marker & join to work in the round

Round 1: *K1, P1; repeat from * to end

Repeat round 1 until ribbing measures 1" from CO

edge

Change to larger, 24" circular needle

Body

With color A

Set-up round: K

Knit rounds 1-24 of colorwork chart two times

Repeat knit rounds 1-12 of colorwork chart one more time

Change to smaller, 24" circular needle

Ribbing

With color A

Round 1: *K1, P1; repeat from * until end

Repeat round 1 until ribbing measures 1"

Finishing

Using larger, 24" circular needle, bind-off loosely in

Cut yarn leaving a 6"-8" tail

Weave in ends

Lightly wet or steam block

Enjoy!

Abbreviation Key

CO: Cast on

K: Knit

P: Purl

K2TOG: Knit 2 stitches

together

PM: Place marker
